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The Creative Act, component part of Cultural Heritage

Creativity within the Setting

A case study, approached at different scales of interest, has already passed through several acts of creativity ("chain of creativity acts"): construction, use, transformation and destiny.

Creativity in its tangible manifestation of the built environment through construction materials and techniques that responded "creatively" to a specific environment and need (i.e., economic, social, cultural, political). Creativity in the built legacy's transmission through use, reuse, adaptation, transformation, and preservation.

Circularity between Conservation and Creativity.







How can a creative act from a conservation perspective relate to the tangible and intangible manifestations of a setting?

Does a creative act in conservation relate differently to the tangible and intangible aspects of a legacy?

Create *new* communities through preservation tools that we can embrace and implement rooted in knowledge and acknowledge of the built environment?

Does *new* communities imply *new* identities?

Co-creating the meanings with local communities and the difference from the creative act of the preserving process?

Creativity in translating the local population needs?

Stimulate through the intervention the appropriation of the existing built environment to local community.

A Creative Act in Conservation should aim for:


- Transmitting and translating the inheritance of the built environment.

- Interdisciplinary approach for an optimal solution.
